

River Heights Utah Stake Emergency Action Plan

Purpose and Key Personnel

A two-page summary of the River Utah Stake Emergency Action Plan. This plan outlines actions to be taken by the Ward and Stake levels. Each ward should have its own emergency action plan binder that outlines individualized needs and available equipment within their ward area.

Emergency Response Procedures

The Stakes Emergency Preparedness Action Plan follows priesthood and local church leadership Chain of Command. The primary goal of the emergency action plan is to ensure human safety. Its secondary goal is to reestablish self-reliance within wards.

1. Communication & Gathering Locations

- a. In the event of an emergency, ward members meet at their assigned ward buildings.
- b. The Stake Center will function as the Command Center and a local gathering location.
- c. Communication between the gathering sites and Command Center will be conducted in the following order based on the event, scenario, and availability:
 - i. Cell Phone
 - ii. Hand Held Radios (2 radios located at each building)
 - iii. Designated Runners with predetermined meeting times.

2. Rapid Assessments

- a. After gathering, local leaders will begin rapid assessment
 - i. Send out able and capable people in groups of 2 to the ward house by house.
 - ii. Confirm people are safe in each home.
 - iii. Anyone requiring immediate assistance is helped on the spot immediately by trained first responders (911). If they are not available then by volunteers.
 - iv. Rapid assessment teams should continue the assessment and hand off first response as quickly as possible to neighbors or other volunteers.
 - v. Document non-emergency needs by address and report back to local leaders at the gather area.
 - vi. Local wards marshal local resources. Greater needs are communicated to Stake.
 - vii. Stake Communications Director communicates with cities and Church Area.

3. Recovery

- a. First aid stations should be established at each location as needed in coordination with Stake Leadership.
- b. Recovery plans are devised and put in place in each ward as appropriate based on the situation and event needs.

Stake Callings and Responder Procedure

In the event of an emergency, Stake Representatives should first ensure their families are safe, then establish communication with the Stake Command Center to identify immediate needs that need to be addressed.

1. Establish Communication with ward buildings per the above communication channels
2. Ensure the Priesthood Chain of Command has been notified at the Stake level
3. Establish Area communication via predefined communication channels
4. Assist local wards with recovery
